

THE HUCKNALL FLYING HIGH ACADEMY

OVER SUBSCRIPTION CRITERIA

The Hucknall Flying High Academy has identified that the nursery provision is predominately for 3 year olds, but in line with parent request two Extended Day places per day have been allocated for 2 year olds [maximum of 3 places per day at each Extended ½ day session in the case of the over-subscription criteria not being applied].

The Nursery has space for 26 children during each of the sessions, with some flexibility over lunchtime. In response to this places for over-subscription purposes have been allocated in relation to the following:

3 year olds

- 14 Extended Day Places (either full day or ½ day places equating to a full day place each day)
- 10 Core Day Places (either full day or ½ day places equating to a full day place across the week)
- Any place

2 year olds

- 2 Extended Day places (either full day or ½ day places equating to a full day place each day)
- Any place

In response to the places identified above the places for 3 year olds will be allocated in line with:

Children who are 3 years of age prior to the term in which the admission criteria are being applied for (31 st August/ 31 st December/ 31 st March)	i) Looked after children and children who were previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to adoption, a child arrangement order, or special guardianship order ii) Children by distance from the academy, with priority for admission given to children who live nearest to the academy as measured using Ordnance Survey data to plot an address. Distances are measured from the main entrance of the child's address to the door outside the academy's reception on the site where the child will predominantly be based, and who, at the time of admission will have a brother or sister attending the school. iii) Children by distance from the academy, with priority for admission given to children who live nearest to the academy, in line with the criteria identified above iv) Other Children	Where there are place not yet allocated - move to STEP FOUR
